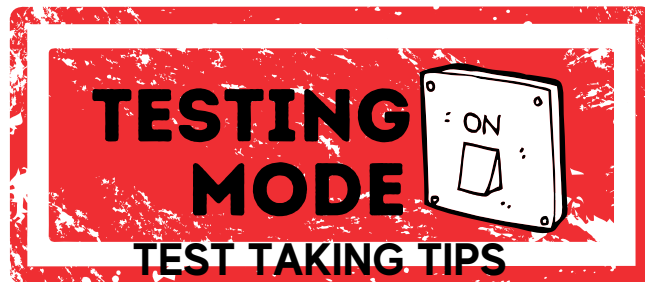

The Amite County School District would like to salute Mr. Harness for his endless sacrifice to our school district.

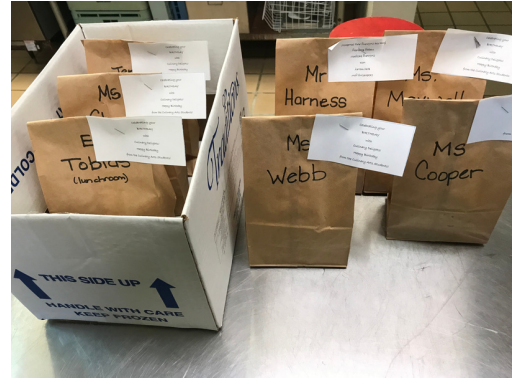
